JOB TITLE: Public Health Nurse

DIVISION: Clinical

IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR: Health Department Administrator

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

I. General Public Health Related Activities

- a. Collaborates in the development of and contributes to individual, team, and agency quality improvement and evaluation activities.
- b. Builds and maintains effective relationships with fellow staff members and promotes a positive work environment.
- c. Demonstrates and promotes a culture of respect and cultural sensitivity in their interactions with the public and other staff.
- d. Maintains and demonstrates public health and clinical nursing knowledge and skills, staying current with trends and continuing education requirements.
- e. Protects and safeguards confidential agency and client information; exercises sound judgment and caution in communication and transmission of information in accordance with HIPPA policy and guidelines.
- f. Provides emergency response in accordance with current BLS guidelines and agency emergency protocols as needed.
- g. Must be able to drive to Ray County Health Department locations, or off-site locations as needed, to perform all required and essential job-related activities and tasks.

II. Nursing Related Activities

- a. Provides a wide range of public health nursing services for clients of all ages, including,
 - a) health screenings
 - b) immunizations
 - c) health education
 - d) lead testing
 - e) Communicable Disease testing and control
 - f) other clinical services as needed
- b. Completes all documentation as needed assuring for accuracy, confidentiality, and timeliness.
- c. Provides a wide range of public health outreach nursing services for clients which may include travel to homes, schools, organizations, and clinics as needed.
- d. Provides general public health information and answers questions as needed per phone or faceto-face consultation assuring for accuracy.

- e. Participates in the planning and development of public health programs and nursing services, including community assessments, assuring for professionalism.
- f. Ensures quality and accuracy of assigned program activities.
- g. Participates in the operation of other community health programs as needed to ensure coverage.
- h. Maintains knowledge of community resources, referring clients to services as needed.
- i. Interprets data, monitors trends, and establishes appropriate prevention and control measures as needed.
- j. Maintains an awareness and understanding of the various medications and immunizations practices, including administration, side effects and proper storage and handling.
- k. Demonstrates and teaches nursing self-care to clients and the general public as needed; communicated with the public on a wide range of public health topics.
- I. Prepares for and participates in regular meetings with staff and others as required.

III. Qualifications

- a. Applicants must have earned a high school diploma or GED (a high school equivalency diploma), passed the TEAS Exam, completed an accredited LPN program, and passed the NCLEX-PN Exam.
- b. Applicants must possess a current LPN license in the State of Missouri.

Employees will be required to follow any other job-related instructions and to perform any other Health Department related duties requested by their supervisor, subject to reasonable accommodations.
